WTR Maximum Weekly Working Time

Script Type:

To-Do List

Overview

This script is designed to highlight any maximum weekly working time WTR breaches on the to-do list so that a manager can then act on it. It is a to-do list only script to be used in conjunction with the WTR maintenance script.

Dependencies

- WTR Maintenance Event Handler Script. It will produce no data without this!

Operation Example

- An employee breaches the WTR maximum weekly working time rule then a to-do list item will be presented on the to-do list. By default this is 48 hours.

Configuration

- Assigned against the managers to-do list policy under the 'scripting' option. Tick the WTR Maximum Weekly Working Time.
- Values can be changed via File -> Reporting -> Working Time Regulations. Default is 48 hours over a 7 day period averaged over 17 weeks.

Explanation of notable fields

Private Const LOOKBACK_PERIOD As Long = 7	Number of days the to-do list will look back on for breaches. Any breaches older than this date will not appear.
Private Const SHOW_TOP_N_RECORDS As Long = 50	Number of breaches that can appear on a managers to-do list.
